

Fax Services



The Waltham Public Library does not have a public Fax machine. However, if you want to send a fax, you do have several options:

- Across the street from the library is The UPS Store. For domestic faxes, they charge \$2 for the first page and \$1 for each additional page.
- Fax Zero: <http://faxzero.com/> is an online service where you can send faxes for free (3 page max). If you want to send more pages, there is a charge. You can either type in a message or upload a file from your computer. They will attach an advertisement to your fax.
- Free Fax Button: <http://www.freefaxbutton.com> is an online service where you can send up to two faxes per day for free. You can either type in a message or upload a file from your computer. They will attach an advertisement to your fax.
